

2023 NASA Express Cup Rules, Points, and Details

A NASA Express Cup points system is being utilized this year for our members. Robert Singleterry will administer the points and they will be placed on the NGA website when the results are known after each tournament. This document outlines the rules, points, and details of the Cup.

- Minimum of 5 out of 11 tournaments must be played and scores registered to be eligible (the more you play, the more points you can earn).
- Each player is guaranteed 100 pts for playing in a tournament. See Table 1 for points by place.
- Ties by place will be summed and divided by the the number of folks who tied (average the points among the tied players).
- Low Net and Low Gross points are non-exclusive and additive.
- Each closest to the pin is awarded 50 points and is non-exclusive and additive. If there is no winner, no points are awarded.
- NASA Express points are awarded for each tournament where each player has an individual score (e.g., Captain's Choice does not count).
- If you play in all the tournaments, then a 500 point bonus will be awarded
- For the Cypress Creek Tournament, all points are doubled (allows some make up if you cannot make all the tournaments).
- NASA Express pays by flight. 50\$ per flight (150\$ total). The flight pay out is determined by the last tournament the golfer played in.
- Ties in each flight at the end of season will be broken by the player that has the largest number of Low Gross points.
- If both total and Low Gross points are still the same, then the number of points from the closet to the pin category is used.
- If still tied, then the tied players will have the 50\$ divided equally among them.
